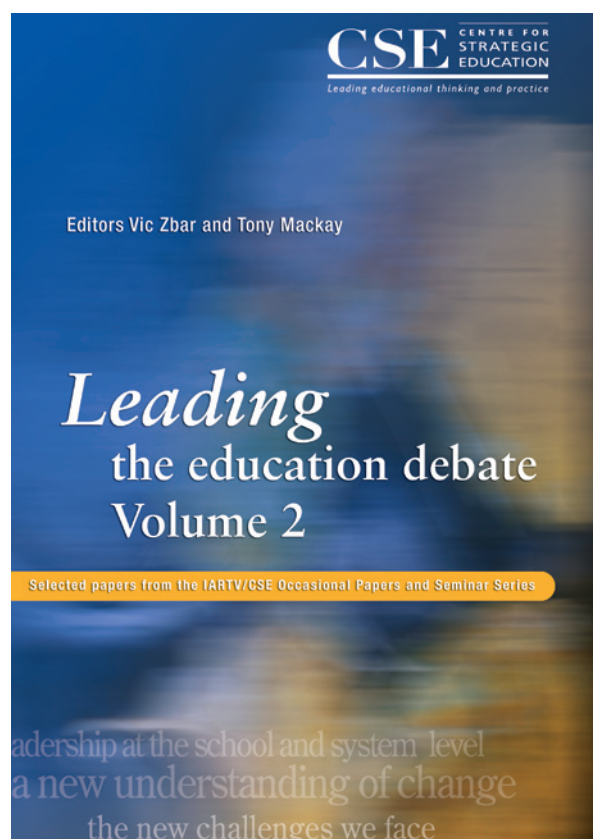
Four years on, while much remains the same, much also has changed.
