In 2003, the Centre for Strategic Education consolidated a selection of the best of its ground-breaking series of seminar papers from a decade of cutting-edge contributions to educational discourse into *Leading the education debate*. This collection included some of the most recognised names in education, writing about structures for improvement and change, curriculum and assessment, teaching and learning, the key role of leadership, and building the teaching profession.
